IV. Management of Life Outreach Center

The management of Life Outreach Center will consist of two separate yet integrated teams.

- A. Board of Directors consisting of the Founding members who have legal and corporate responsibilities, but will not be involved in the day to day management of Life Outreach Center.
- B. A Directing Staff responsible for overseeing all areas of ministry on a daily basis. The Executive Director will be appointed by the Board of Directors and will be a non-voting board member.

Statement of Principle

1. Life Outreach Center is a ministry of Jesus Christ through His church. Therefore, we are committed to presenting the gospel of our Lord to women with crisis pregnancies– both in word and in deed. Commensurate with this purpose, those who labor as pregnancy care center board members, directors, and volunteers are expected to know Christ as their Savior and Lord.
2. Life Outreach Center is committed to providing its clients with accurate and complete information about for prenatal development an abortion.
3. Life Outreach Center is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust, and providing promised information and services. The pregnancy care center denounces any form of deception in it's corporate advertising or individual conversations with its clients.
4. Life Outreach Center is committed to assisting women to carry to term by providing emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large women may face the future with hope, and plan constructively for themselves and their babies.
5. Life Outreach Center does not discriminate in providing services because of race, creed, color, national origin, age or marital status of its clients.
6. Life Outreach Center does not recommend, provide, or refer for an abortion or abortifacients.
7. Life Outreach Center offers assistance free of charge at all times
8. Life Outreach Center is committed to creating an awareness within the local community of the needs of pregnant women, and the fact that abortion only compounds human need rather than resolving it.
9. Life Outreach Center does not recommend, provide, or refer single women for contraceptive. (Married women seeking contraceptive information should be urged to seek counsel, along with their husbands, from their pastors and physicians.
10. Life Outreach Center recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion, but it is not biased towards adoption when compared to other life-saving alternatives. Centers are independent of adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources. Pregnancy care centers received no payment of any kind from these agencies, do not enter into contractual relationships with them, and do not share combined office space. Adoption agencies are not established under the auspices of centers. Pregnancy care centers neither initiate nor facilitate independent adoptions, though they may refer for independent adoptions in states where it is legal.

The Pregnancy care center Statement of Faith

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authorized Word of God.
2. We believe there is one God, eternally existent in three persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, and in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and His personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe that for the salvation of the lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential, and that this salvation is received through faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and not as a result of good works.
5. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life and to perform good works.
6. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
7. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers and in our Lord Jesus Christ.
